- Physics research;
- Physics education research;
- Any idea that would be useful to physics teachers at any level of instruction.

All abstracts must be **received by March 2** to insure inclusion in the program. Please prepare your submission according to the following guidelines:

- All copy must be **typed and double spaced**;
- Including footnotes, text must be **limited to 150 words**;
- Include author's names, school or company affiliations, addresses, zip codes, and office telephone numbers for those not able to hear your paper in person;
- References must be set in the text in brackets, not as footnotes;
- Please list a **possible session topic** that would be appropriate for your paper.

Presentations will be scheduled to run 15 minutes including questions. Special time requests will be considered if time permits. Please indicate any **special equipment needed**.
